**Title:** Who is Buried in the Lead Coffin? Part Two

be able to solve the mystery of the Three Lead Coffins.

**Directions:** Your job today is to learn terminology related to archaeology to solve the mystery of the coffins using the Solve the Mystery of the Lead Coffins interactive. Use the link below to open the interactive and then, click through the pages until you reach page 26. Open the Archaeology Log 2 worksheet and continue on the dig, stopping to record necessary information in the log. You will be asked to stop on page 28 and page 32 in the interactive to make predictions on what will happen on the dig. After you make the prediction, go to the next page to find out what really happened. If you need help defining the vocabulary terms you may click back to the beginning of the interactive.
