- The man must have had a wife.
- The man *may* have had a child, but there *might not* be a record of her.
- If there was a child, it must have been a girl.
- The order of death was:
 - 1) Woman
 - 2) Man
 - 3) Child
- The seasons of death were:
 - 1) Woman – Fall
 - 2) Man – Winter
 - 3) Child – Spring
